First Lutheran Preschool is about providing children with the self-confidence and academic basis they need to transition into kindergarten.

We are seeking a patient, cheerful and enthusiastic individual who is able to accept and adapt to change (e.g., shifting priorities, demands, and timelines) through time management, analytical, and problem-solving skills, while being a self-starter with ability to take ownership and accountability of all roles and responsibilities with minimal supervision. Plan and implement daily activities that provide for the balanced, Christian growth of the children.

Will administer the preschool program in accordance with state rules and regulations. This person needs to have an aptitude in early childhood curriculum, arts and crafts. Must understand the social, psychological and recreational needs of children of various ages; and able to plan and organize learning opportunities geared to student needs. The ability to organize, plan, and work with a teaching assistant. The capacity to grasp new theories and principles and implement them.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

A Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education, an Associate Degree in early childhood education, a CDA; or an equivalent combination of education and experience will be considered.

TRAINING REQUIRED:

During employment, the preschool teacher is required to attend conferences such as the Early Childhood Conference and similar workshops to collect new theories and approaches to teaching the children at FLP. Documentation of these courses taken will be presented to the Director through a transcript and placed in the teacher's personnel file.

Must become certified in infant, child and adult CPR in addition to Red Cross First Aid.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, sit, kneel, lift and or move up to 25 pounds, talk or hear, use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls, and reach with hands and arms. Specific vision requirements include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
